JFM Sprint, World Ranking Event 23 August 2026

Type of competition, format: Sprint, WRE

Competition area: Vejle town centre

Venue: <https://maps.app.goo.gl/pjX37tjKBk1DPStE8>

Course length: 12-15 min winning time for W21 and M21

Terrain: The competition area includes a complex old town area with shopping streets, backyards and narrow alleyways. Modern residential areas with apartment buildings, public buildings and schools are also present. The area is nearly flat and the ground surface will mainly be hard, but some areas with soft ground (mainly grass) can also be expected.

Weather conditions: Temperatures often reach 22°C during daytime. Rainfall is frequent and can be heavy.

First start: 10.00

Prize giving ceremony: Immediately after the race

Embargoed areas: Please find the embargoed area [here](#). Embargoed area. Competitors, team officials, and other persons, who, through knowledge of the terrain may influence the results of the competition, are not allowed to enter an embargoed area, unless explicitly permitted by the organiser. Access along certain roads are permitted. It is also permitted to enter shops and other buildings located along the road. The embargo is valid until the competition is finished.

Instructions about how to enter through the embargo to the parking site, how to get from parking to the arena, and how to get from Vejle Train station to the arena will follow in Bulletin 2.

Be aware that the embargo will be changed on the day of the event. The embargo will be full, meaning that access along permitted roads will not be allowed anymore. More information will follow in Bulletin 2.

Punching system: Sport Ident Air+ Touch Free. Rental of punching card is possible: 20 DKK.

Map: 1:4,000, contour interval 2.5 m, ISSprOM 2019-2 Revision 6, drawn in 2022 by Gediminas Trimakas and updated in 2026 by Quentin Moulet. Pre-existing orienteering map can be downloaded from [IOF Eventor](#).

WRE classes: W21, M21

Other classes: There will be classes open for all ages (W/M10 to W/M90). See information on [our event website](#) (in Danish).

Quarantine: There will be no quarantine. In Bulletin 2, it will be informed where it is allowed to stay during the event.

Travel information: The travel distance by car is about 30 km from Billund Airport, 260 km from Hamburg Airport and 240 km from Copenhagen Airport. The distance from Vejle Train station is 500 m.

Parking: Information will follow in Bulletin 2.

Accommodation: The region offers a wide range of accommodation, from five-star hotels to cabins and hostels. For information, please contact [Visit Vejle](#).

Entry fee: 100 DKK, late entries +30 DKK.

Entry deadline: August 14th at 23:59. Late entries accepted until August 18th at 23:59.
